Describe Adjacency to Public/Private Conservation Lands:

Immediately adjacent to the northeast of the Protected Property is a 155-acre perpetual conservation easement held by the Land Trust. Within 3 miles of the Protected Property are seven other private properties permanently protected with conservation easements held by the Minnesota Land Trust, three federal Waterfowl Production Areas, two Stearns County parks, two DNR Aquatic Management Areas, and one DNR Scientific and Natural Area. The 2,900-acre Saint John's Abbey Arboretum is also nearby and includes 1,800 acres of an MBS Site of Outstanding Biodiversity Significance; it has served as a designated state wildlife refuge since 1933.
