MS 116P.09 Subd 6 Conflict of interest. A commission member, technical advisory committee member, a peer review panelist, or an employee of the commission may not participate in or vote on a decision of the commission, technical advisory committee, or peer review panel relating to an organization in which the member, panelist, or employee has either a direct or indirect personal financial interest. While serving on the commission, technical advisory committee, or peer review panel, or being an employee of the commission, a person shall avoid any potential conflict of interest.

NOTE: Requires affirmative vote of 12 members

- **Camp Kingswood property to be acquired has a conservation easements that were funded by ENRTF in M.L. 2009, Chp. 143, Sec. 2, Subd. 04f3.2 & M.L. 2010, Chp. 362, Sec. 2, Subd. 04g3.2 for a total of \$172,500, Minnesota Land Trust and M.L. 2001, First Special Session, Chp. 2, Sec. 14, Subd. 04g “Metro Greenways”, DNR Metro Greenways**
- **M.S. 116P.18 Lands in Public Domain**

Arne Stefferud, Metropolitan Council and Margie Dahlof (Three Rivers Park District) requested adding the Camp Kingswood property onto their acquisition list for M.L. 2011, First Special Session, Chp. 2, Art. 3, Sec. 2, Subd. 04c “Metropolitan Regional Park System Acquisition.

MOTION: Commissioner Gibson moved to approve adding Camp Kingswood to the acquisition list to M.L. 2011, First Special Session, Chp. 2, Art. 3, Sec. 2, Subd. 04c “Metropolitan Regional Park System Acquisition” to allow the fee title purchase for this parcel – motion prevailed (16 ayes).

9. **Continuation of 6/11/2013 Agenda - Partial easement conveyance approval requested for Camp Kingswood property in M.L. 2001, First Special Session, Chp. 2, Sec. 14, Subd. 04g “Metro Greenways”, MN DNR as required by M.S. 116P.15, DNR - Jodi Dehn, Realty Supervisor, Division of Lands and Minerals**

Three Rivers Park District and the DNR requested that the LCCMR approve partial release of the conservation easement for Camp Kingswood property that was purchased with funds from in M.L. 2001, First Special Session, Chp. 2, Sec. 14, Subd. 04g "Metro Greenways." The request was made to accommodate future regional trail development through the property consistent with the approved regional trail plan. As required by M.S. 116P.15 the request for the approval of the release of a portion of the previous conservation easement was brought before and approved by the LCCMR at the June 25, 2013 LCCMR meeting.

In regard to the release of the portion the conservation easement it was determined by the DNR that the state should be paid back \$17,800 for the partial release of the easement. The

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Environment and Natural Resources Trust Fund (ENRTF) will be paid back proportional to its original investment in the purchase of the easement which was 28.4%. The proportional amount to be paid to the ENRTF is \$4,414.40.

MOTION: Commissioner Torkelson moved to approve conveyance as proposed by DNR to Three Rivers Park District for a trail – motion prevailed (no opposition).

Susan Schmidt, The Trust for Public Land and Jacob Frei, Crow Wing County, requested to add Upper Cullen Lake to their acquisition list and to have Crow Wing County be the owner instead of DNR.

Co-Chair Wagenius said the tax assessment given by Susan Schmidt (\$900,000) is very different than what House Research has given at ~\$300,000.

Mike Banker, LCCMR staff, provided a brief update. He explained that presently the work plan is broken down into 11 subprojects with some of the subprojects not starting for a year or more. He explained they do not have a detailed breakdown for years 3-6 so the budget will be set two years at a time. Every two years they will give an update to the full commission and staff will work

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closely with Peter Sorensen for minor adjustments needed within the subprojects. Each subproject will have its own work plan and detailed budget.

Peter Sorensen, U of MN, answered questions by members regarding the work plan M.L. 013, Chp. 52, Sec. 2, Subd. 06a "An Aquatic Invasive Species Research Center".
