

Predesign Addendum

Updated: December 23, 2024

Purpose: This document is an Addendum to the Department of Administration's Predesign Template and Projects (Seventh Edition). This document provides LCCMR / ENRTF specific requirements, along with a transmittal template letter for completing predesign review of ENRTF funded capital construction projects.

Capital construction projects¹ funded using the Environment and Natural Resources Trust Fund (ENRTF) must complete predesign review with the <u>Minnesota Department of Administration</u>, unless the project is exempt under <u>Minnesota Statutes §16B.335</u>, as determined by the Legislative-Citizen Commission on Minnesota Resources (LCCMR).

This addendum provides the following for ENRTF project managers:

- 1. A table of statutory requirements (included on page 2 of this document) specific to ENRTF capital construction projects to be used in place of the table found in Section 4 Appendix 4c of the predesign manual and template. The highlighted text indicates differences between requirements for projects receiving state bond funding and ENRTF funding.
- A sample predesign submittal cover letter for ENRTF capital construction projects that may be used instead of the letter found on page 51 of the Predesign Manual and page 44 of the Predesign Template.

In addition, project managers should note that ENRTF capital construction projects will follow the LCCMR process, unless otherwise directed by the legislature, rather than the legislative review as outlined in paragraph 2 of the predesign checklist preamble found on page 41 of the Predesign Manual and page 33 of the Predesign Template.

¹ For the ENRTF, capital construction is defined as the pre-design, design, construction, or renovation of a building, trail or campground, or other long-lived (10 years or more) fixed capital asset costing \$10,000 or more. This includes large-scale stream or wetland restoration, or acquisition of land for purposes of capital construction.
